MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENTS

- The parking lot in the south is close to being completed. When it is open for us to use, they will continue the driveway between the two lots as well as the pickleball court in the back of the building. I mention the parking lot because we the board still get questions about when it will be completed and open. As I get information, I will pass it along but, as you know these plans are out of my hands and I can only inform everyone when I get the information.
- As for the pickleball court, this will be a town court and they will be responsible for maintaining the grounds as well as informing everyone of the play time. There will be a sign informing everyone that you can play for 30 minutes at a time, and if there are people waiting, you need to allow the changeover to happen. When it gets closer to being open, I will be ensuring there is a sign with a phone number for people to call if there are any issues. We at the centre will not be able to intervene as it will be handled the same as the courts at ACC or Audley.
- Another item of interest from the town is their Curbside Giveaway that is scheduled for Saturday September 16th. There is a rain date (Saturday September 23 same time) start by 7am to end at 7 pm. The pilot project event, organized in cooperation with the local municipalities, allows residents in participating municipalities to place unwanted items, in good condition, clearly marked FREE on their curb for anyone to pick up. 
