MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENTS

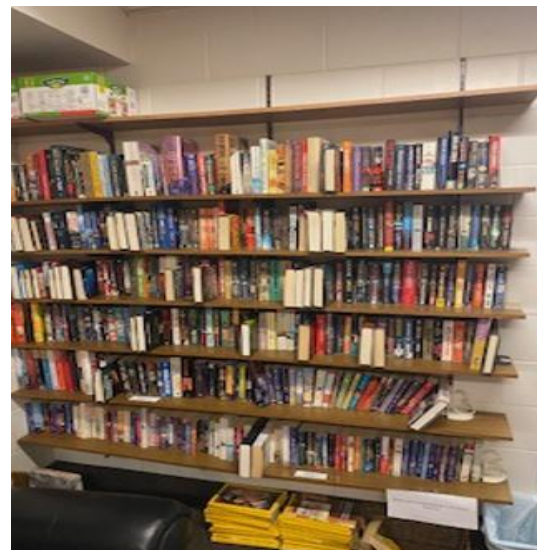
